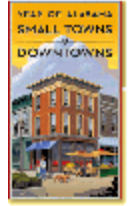




64th Chickasaw Founders Day Exhibitor/Vendor Information



Dear Exhibitor/Vendor:

The 64th Chickasaw Founders Day celebrating the incorporation of the city, will be held on Saturday, October 30, 2010, from 9:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. in Paul DeVine Park and McConnell Civic Center at 200 Grant Street in Chickasaw, Alabama, celebrating the historical contributions of our community as a small town in the State of Alabama and in the United States.

The event is a reunion of citizens of Chickasaw, past residents and their families and people who worked in the businesses or passed through our beautiful small town on their travels. It is a time to share memories, remember great times with friends and family and a time to celebrate our community as a great place to live where ‘everybody is someone in Chickasaw.’ The city will receive one of 215 historical markers to commemorate Alabama’s “Year of Small Towns and Downtowns” statewide celebration in 2010.

We invite you to join us as an exhibitor for a day of arts & crafts, historical visual displays, trains, petting zoo, games, food, and entertainment – for the entire family from young to old. Come join over 1,000 festival goers, who participate in old-fashioned games, kids area activities, and local entertainment in the amphitheater.

Exhibitor spaces are \$20 per 12’x12’ space and need to be reserved before October 15. You will need to supply your own tables, chairs and table covering or tent (if used). A tent is highly recommended. Event set-up times will be Friday, 3-8 p.m. and Saturday 6-8 a.m. The event opens to the public at 9 a.m. All exhibitors will need to be completely set-up prior to the event opening time. We would love for you to be a part of our event. Event guidelines are attached.

Proceeds from this event will benefit the Chickasaw Chamber of Commerce community projects and future Founders Day celebrations.

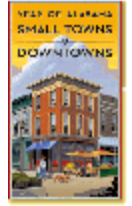

64th Founders Day Exhibitor/Vendor Guidelines

Location: Paul DeVine Park, and J. McConnell Civic Center at 200 Grant Street, Chickasaw, AL.

Event Set-up: Friday set-up is strongly encouraged and is from 3-8 p.m. with vendor registration at the McConnell Civic Center. Vendors are responsible for furnishing their own tents, displays, tables and chairs. Committee volunteers will direct vendors to assigned spaces. The committee will inspect all booths prior to festival opening time and reserves the right to close any booth if any rules and regulations are being violated.

Vehicles: Only 1 vehicle per site to provide convenience for all vendors. Once a vehicle is parked, it cannot be moved until 4 p.m. on Saturday. No vehicle will be allowed in any festival area after 8 a.m. due to logistics. Exhibitors should remain during the entire duration of the festival. No RVs or campers are allowed on festival premises.

Entry Fees: An exhibitor is any individual, club, nonprofit organization, church or business. No resale of booth space by exhibitor is allowed. Booth space reverts to the festival committee for no-shows. No refunds will be given as a result of poor weather.

No explosive devices or replicas of weapons will be distributed in any manner (sold or given as prizes.) This will include popping caps and foul-smelling "toys." No drug-related paraphernalia and NO knives will be distributed in any manner.

Arts & Crafts Vendors: Please submit a photo of your art or craft with your application.

Food Vendors: Food vendors must contact Mobile County Health Department for permit at least four weeks prior to festival. (Telephone: (251) 690-8116). A valid food permit from the Health Department must be displayed. Electric hook-ups and water will be available, if noted on application. Food vendors may sell lemonade, frozen drinks, water, tea and coffee.

Sponsor Exhibitors: Sponsor exhibitors must contact sponsor chairperson to find out what exhibit space they occupy. All guides apply to sponsor exhibitors. Please make sure that promotional materials are not harmful to children. Sponsor fees include exhibit space.

Vendor Business License: It is the individual responsibility of each vendor to ensure their compliance with any state of Alabama, Mobile County or City of Chickasaw licensing requirements.

Promotion: The committee will advertise several months in local, state and regional tourism brochures, newspapers, radio and television and websites.
